MAKE A STERLING SILVER RING

Make a ring using sterling silver strip that has a design OR you can make a unique ring by sawing a design or making your own texture on ¼ inch sterling strip. If ring is for someone else, you must know the size or have a ¼inch strip of paper that you wrapped around knuckle of finger and marked with length around knuckle. You will use basic metal smithing techniques (sawing, filing, shaping, soldering and polishing) to make ring. Tools will be available for class use. Samples will be on display at BAC. (Maximum cost for average ring based on weight of silver used. Please contact instructor through BAC if you plan to bring your own sterling silver.)
